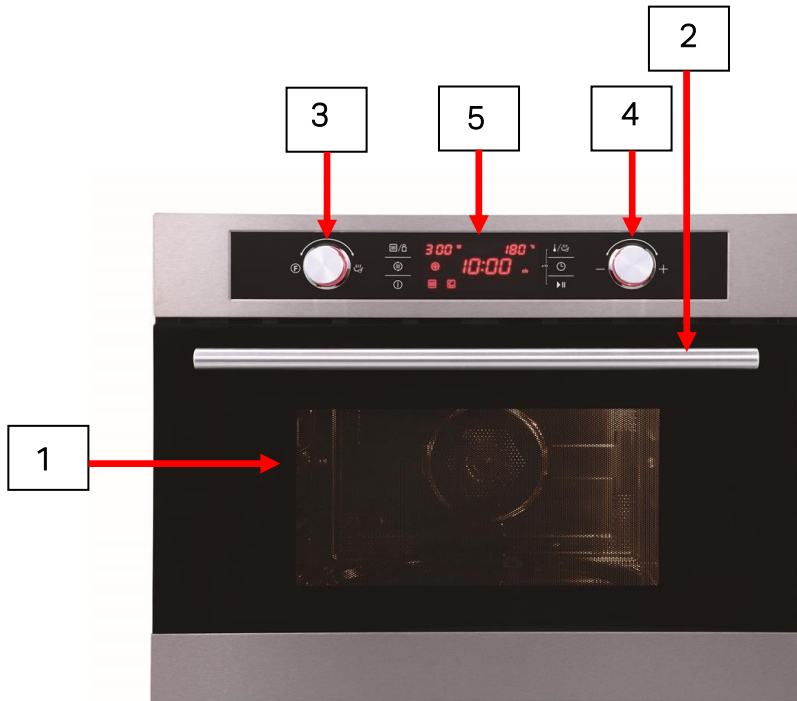

Section 1. Installation

- **This appliance must be installed by a Qualified Electrical Engineer.**
- Remove all packaging, protective film and securing tape from the appliance.
- Wash the interior of the appliance with warm soapy water.
- Position the appliance in a dry atmosphere.
- Keep the microwave oven away from the TV, Radio or antenna as picture disturbance or noise may occur.
- Please note that certain parts of this appliance have been protected with a light film of oil. During initial use you may see light smoke coming from the oven as the oil is burnt off. This is quite normal.
- Never operate this oven without food or liquids inside
- Remove the turntable and rotating ring from the packaging, wash in warm soapy water and dry thoroughly. Fit the rotating ring on the base of the interior and then carefully place the turntable onto the rotating drive, ensuring that it 'locks' into place.
- The turntable and rotating ring can be removed from the appliance and washed using warm soapy water
- Replace the rotating ring on the base of the interior and then carefully place the turntable onto the rotating drive, ensuring that it 'locks' into place
- This appliance is fitted with a safety door interlock. Do not operate the appliance if either of the two interlock levers are damaged. Please note that the appliance will fail to operate if the door has not been closed correctly.
- The turntable rotates whilst the appliance is operating – this helps the food/liquids to cook/heat more evenly.

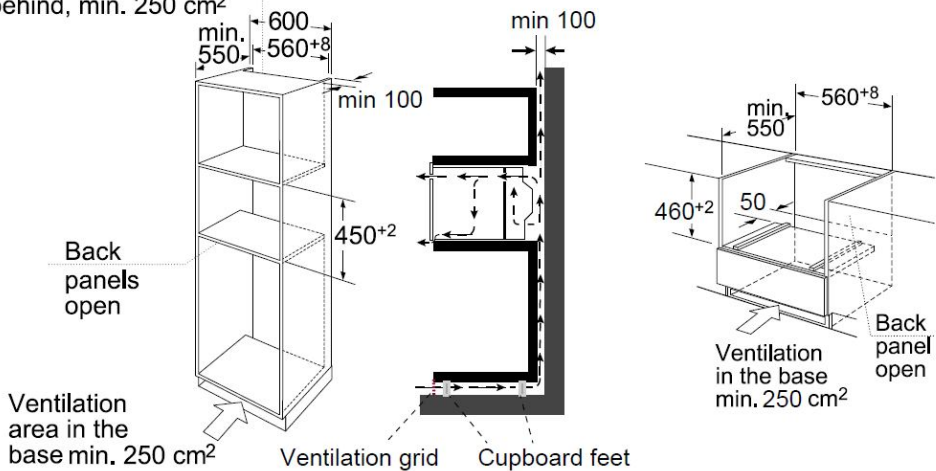
N.B. This appliance must be installed by a Qualified electrical engineer/installer.

To install this appliance, please proceed as shown in diagrams below:

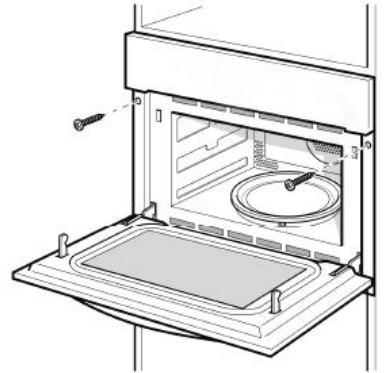
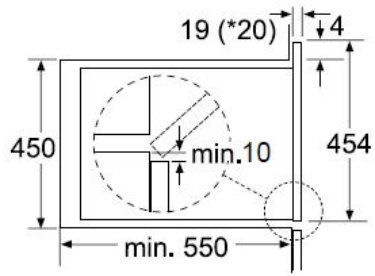
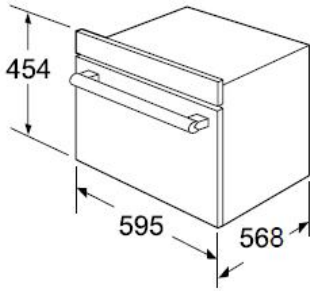
- Your engineer will ensure that this appliance is connected in accordance with current regulations. **It cannot be connected to a 13AMP power supply!**
- **Please note that the appliance has a maximum Power Input of 3350W.**
- A gap of at least 100mm must be maintained between the rear wall and the rear of the unit.
- You must ensure that there is a ventilation opening of at least 250cm² in the 'kickboard' at the base of the housing unit.
- Do not lift the appliance by using the door handle!

Section 2. Safety Advice

- Please read this booklet thoroughly before installing and switching on the appliance. The manufacturer accepts no responsibility for incorrect installation and usage.
- This appliance is guaranteed for Domestic Use Only.
- The appliance shall not be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction on how to use the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- This appliance must only be used for cooking/heating foods and liquids. Do not use it for any other purpose.
- If using an adaptor, this must be used in accordance with the manufacturers instructions and ensure that the electrical circuit is not overloaded as this could cause overheating.
- Do not twist or bend the cables, and keep them away from hot surfaces.
- If the power supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, it's service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- Do not plug in or unplug this appliance with wet hands.
- Following installation make sure that the power cable is not trapped underneath the appliance.
- Remove all twist-ties from food bags before placing them in the oven.
- Do not heat oil or fat inside the oven.
- Do not over cook food inside the oven.
- Do not heat sealed containers or try to cook eggs (inside their shells) in this oven – they may explode.
- Potatoes, sausages and items such as chestnuts must be peeled or pierced before placing them in the oven.
- After liquids have been heated in the oven wait a few moments before removing the container – handle with care as the container may be hot – use protective gloves.

- Liquids and foods should be stirred and the temperature checked prior to consumption.
- If you cover a container with cling film, remove it very carefully after the cooking process has finished – steam will escape and may burn your hands.
- Always let the turntable cool down before washing it.
- Never cook foods directly on the turntable.
- Make sure that plates/dishes do not touch the walls when the turntable rotates.
- Keep the interior surfaces clean. Failure to do this could lead to the appliance malfunctioning.

Important Utensil Information:

- Do not use metal pans or dishes with metal handles.
- Do not use anything with a metal trim.
- Do not use paper covered wire twist-ties on plastic bags.
- Do not use melamine dishes as they contain a material which will absorb microwave energy. This may cause the dishes to crack or burn, and will slow down the cooking speed.
- Use only cookware that is approved to be used in a microwave oven.
- Do not cook using a container with a restricted opening, such as bottles, as they may explode.
- Do not heat baby bottles with the teat left on and remove the teat if replacing the bottle back into the oven.
- Only use thermometers that are approved for microwave ovens.
- Do not use the microwave oven for heating utensils.

3.1.2. Function Selector Knob Settings

Function	Use
3D Hot air	For baking sponge cakes in baking tins, flans and cheesecakes as well as cakes, pizza and small baked items on the baking tray.50°C can maintain the taste of food after heat preservation of 1-2 hours.
Grill with fan	Poultry goes brown and crispy. Baked casseroles and grilled dishes work out best using this setting.
Pizza setting	For frozen convenience products and dishes which require a lot of heat from underneath.

 Grill	Select between the levels high, medium or low. This is ideal if you wish to grill several steaks, sausages, pieces of fish or slices of bread.
 Microwave+Hot air	Use this function to roast meals quickly. And at the same time use the function of 3D Hot air
 Microwave+Grill Fan	Poultry goes brown and crispy. Baked casseroles and grilled dishes work out best using this setting. And use the function to roast meals evenly.
 Microwave+Pizza	Use this function to roast meals quickly. And at the same time use the function of Pizza setting.
 Microwave+Grill	Use this function to cook meals quickly and at the same time give the meal a brown crust.
 Defrost	2 defrosting programmes
 Auto-programms	13 cooking programmes The type of heating and cooking time are set by weight.

3.1.3. +/- Selector Knob

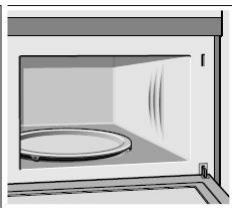
Auto menu	Select 13 automatic programmes. From P 01 to P 13.
Temperature	Select the temperature of cooking(°C).  : 50,100,105,110...230  : 100,105,110...230  : 100,105,110...230  +  : 50,100,105,110...230  +  : 100,105,110...230  +  : 100,105,110...230
Weight	Set the weight of cooking.
Time	Set the time of cooking.

3.2. Cooling Fan

Your appliance is fitted with a cooling fan which will operate while the oven is being used. Warm air is expelled just above the appliance door.

- Do not cover the ventilation grill.
- The cooling fan may continue to operate after you have finished using the appliance – this is quite normal.
- You may see condensation on the door window, interior walls and interior base – this is quite normal. Simply wipe away any condensation with a clean cloth after you have finished cooking.

3.3. Accessories



Turntable

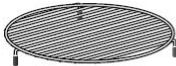
As a surface for the wire rack.

Food which particularly requires a lot of heat from underneath can be prepared directly on the turntable.

The turntable can turn clockwise or anti-clockwise.

Place the turntable on the drive in the centre of the cooking compartment. Ensure that it is properly fitted.

- Never use the microwave without the turntable.
- The turntable can withstand max. 5 kg.
- The turntable must turn when using all types of heating.



Lower wire rack

For the microwave and for baking and roasting in the oven.

Higher wire rack

For grilling, e.g. steaks, sausages and for toasting bread.

As a support for shallow dishes.



Note:

Type and quantity of accessories is subject to actual demand.






3.4. Setting The Clock

Once the appliance is connected, "00:00" will blink, buzzer will ring once. Set the clock.

1. Turn the  knob between 00:00 and 23:59 .
2. Touch the  key.
The time is set.


3.5. Heat the Oven Prior to First Time Use










To remove the new cooker smell, heat up the oven when it is empty and closed. One hour with  Hot air at 230 °C is ideal. Ensure that no packaging remnants have been left in the cooking compartment.

1. Use the function selector  to set  heating mode.
Turn the  knob to select  hot air function.
2. Touch the  key. Turn the  knob to set the temperature to 230 °C.
3. Touch the  key. Turn the  knob to set the cooking time to 60 minutes.
4. Touch the  key. The oven begins to heat up.


3.6. Using The Oven

Example :  Hot air at 200 °C for 25 minutes.

1. Set the function selector  to .
Turn the  knob to .
2. Touch the  key. The default temperature 180 °C will blink.
Turn the  knob to set the temperature to 200 °C.
3. Touch the  key. Turn the  knob to set the cooking time to 25 minutes.
4. Touch the  key. The oven begins to heat up.



Opening the oven door during operation

Operation is suspended. After closing the door, touch the  key. Operation continues.

Pausing operation


Touch the  key to pause operation. Then touch the  key to continue operation.


Changing the cooking time

This can be done at any time. Touch the  key. Turn the  knob to change the cooking time.


Changing the temperature

This can be done at any time.

Touch the  key for the new temperature setting.

Turn the  knob to set the temperature.










Cancelling operation

This can be done at any time. Touch the  key to enter into the off state.


Rapid Preheating


With rapid preheating, your oven reaches the set temperature particularly quickly.


Rapid Preheating is available for the following types of heating:

-  3D Hot air
-  Grill with fan
-  +  Microwave+Hot air
-  +  Microwave+Grill Fan
-  Pizza setting
-  +  Microwave+Pizza

To ensure an oven cooking result, only put your food in the cooking compartment when the preheating phase is complete.


1. Setting the type of heating and temperature.
2. Touch the  key .

The  symbol lights up in the display.


3. Touch the  key .



The oven begins to heat up.

The preheating process is complete

A signal sounds. The  symbol in the display blinks. Put your dish in the oven.

Cancelling rapid preheating

During setting the rapid preheating function, touch the  key can cancel the function.


During rapid preheating, touch the  or the  can cancel the function. Also you can open the door to cancel the function.

- Note:**
1. The rapid preheating function only works if you have already chosen one of the modes above. During preheating, the microwave function is switched off.
 2. Only when you can hear alarm and preheating icon is blinking you can open the door and put food inside.

3.7. Using The Microwave

Microwave power settings

Use the  key to set the desired microwave power.







100W	-Defrosting sensitive/delicate foods -Defrosting irregularly-shaped foods -Softening ice cream -Allowing dough to rise
300 W	-Defrosting -Melting chocolate and butter
450 W	-cooking rice , soup
700 W	-Reheating -cooking mushrooms,shell fish -cooking dishes containing eggs and cheese
900 W	-Boiling water, reheating -cooking chicken, fish, vegetables

Notes

- When you touch a key, the selected power lights up.
- The microwave power can be set to 900 watts for a maximum of 30 minutes. With all other power settings a maximum cooking time of 1 hour 30 minutes is possible.

Setting the microwave

Example: Microwave power setting 300 W, cooking time 17 minutes

1. In the off state, touch the  key to enter microwave function. The default microwave power 900W will appear. And the default cooking time will blink.
2. Touch the  key to activate the microwave power. Turn the  knob to adjust the microwave power to 300W.
3. Touch the  key. Turn the  knob to adjust the cooking time to 17 minutes.
4. Touch the  key.

Operation begins. The cooking time starts counting down in the display.


The cooking time has elapsed

A signal sounds. Microwave operation has finished.

Opening the oven door during operation


Operation is suspended. After closing the door, touch the ►|| key. Operation continues.


Changing the cooking time

This can be done at any time. Touch the ⌚ key. Turn the  knob to change the cooking time.

Changing the microwave power setting

This can be done at any time.

Touch the  key for the new microwave power setting.

Turn the  knob to set the microwave power.


Pausing operation

Touch the ►|| key briefly. The oven is paused. Touch the ►|| key again to continue operation.

Cancelling operation

This can be done at any time. Touch the ⓪ key to enter into the off state.

Notes

- When you set the function selector to , the highest microwave power setting always lights up as the suggested setting.
- If you open the appliance door during cooking, the fan may continue to run.












3.8. Micro-Combi Operation

This involves simultaneous operation of the grill and the microwave. Using the microwave makes your dishes ready more quickly, but they are still nicely browned.

You can switch on all microwave power settings.

Exception: 900 watts

Example: microwave 100 W, 17 minutes and hot air  190 °C.


1. Turn the  knob to . Turn the  knob to .
2. Touch the  key. The default temperature 180 °C will blink. Turn the  knob to set the temperature to 190°C.
3. The default microwave power is 300W. Touch the  key. Turn the  knob to set the microwave power to 100W.
4. Touch the  key. Turn the  knob to set the cooking time to 17 minutes.
5. Touch the  key.

Appliance operation begins. The cooking time starts counting down.



The cooking time has elapsed

A signal sounds. Combination mode has finished.


Opening the oven door during cooking

Operation is suspended. After closing the door, touch the  key briefly. The programme will then continue.

Pausing operation



Touch the  key briefly. The oven is paused. Touch the  key again to continue operation.

Changing the cooking time

This can be done at any time. Touch the  key. Turn the knob to change the cooking time.



Changing the microwave power setting

This can be done at any time.


Touch the  key for the new microwave power setting. Turn the  knob to set the microwave power.

Changing the temperature

This can be done at any time.

Touch the  key for the new temperature setting. Turn the  knob to set the temperature

Cancelling operation

This can be done at any time. Touch the  key to enter into the off state.

3.9. Automatic Operation









The automatic programmes enable you to prepare food very easily. You select the programme and enter the weight of your food. The automatic programme makes the optimum setting. You can choose from 13 programmes.

Always place the food in the cold cooking compartment.

Setting a programme

When you have selected a programme, set the oven. The temperature selector must be in the off position.

Example : Programme 3 with a weight of 1 kilogramme.

1. Set the function selector  to automatic programmes .
- The first programme number appears in the display.
2. Touch the  key. Turn the  knob to select the programme number.
3. Touch the /  key.
4. Turn the  knob to set the weight, cooking time will shown.
5. Touch the  key. The programme starts. You can see the cooking time counting down .

Notes

- The programmes with a * are preheated. During preheating, the cooking time pauses and the preheating symbol is on. After preheating, you will hear an alarm and the preheating symbol will blink.
- The programmes with ** only use the microwave function.


Programme has ended

A signal sounds. The oven stops heating.

Changing the programme

Once you have started the programme, the programme number and weight cannot be changed.

Cancelling the programme








This can be done at any time. Touch the  key to enter into the off state.

Changing the cooking time

If using automatic programmes, you cannot change the cooking time.

3.10. Defrosting Programmes

You can use the 2 defrosting programmes to defrost meat, poultry and bread.

1. Set the function selector  to automatic programmes  .
The first programme number blinks in the display.
2. Turn the  knob to select the programme number.
3. Touch the  /  key.
4. Turn the  knob to set the weight, cooking time will shown.
5. Touch the  key. The programme starts. You can see the cooking time counting down.

Notes

■ Preparing food

Use food that has been frozen at -18 °C and stored in portion-sized quantities that are as thin as possible.

Take the food to be defrosted out of all packaging and weigh it. You need to know the weight to set the programme.

- Liquid will be produced when defrosting meat or poultry. Drain off this liquid when turning meat and poultry and under no circumstances use it for other purposes or allow it to come into contact with other foods.

■ Ovenware

Place the food in a microwaveable shallow dish, e.g. a china or glass plate, but do not cover.

- When defrosting chicken and chicken portions (d 01), an audible signal will sound on two occasions to indicate that the food should be turned.

■ Resting time



The defrosted food should be left to stand for an additional 10 to 30 minutes until it reaches an even temperature. Large pieces of meat require a longer standing time than smaller pieces. Flat pieces of meat and items made from minced meat should be separated from each other before leaving to stand.

After this time, you can continue to prepare the food, even though thick pieces of meat may still be frozen in the middle. The giblets can be removed from poultry at this point.

*During defrosting, place the food on the Lower wire rack

3.11. Time Setting Options

Your oven has various time-setting options. You can use the  key to call up the menu and switch between the individual functions. A time-setting option that has already been set can be changed directly with the  knob.

Setting the cooking time

The cooking time for your meal can be set on the oven. When the cooking time has elapsed, the oven switches itself off automatically. This means that you do not have to interrupt other work to switch off the oven. The cooking time cannot be accidentally exceeded.



The oven starts. The cooking time counts down in the display.

The cooking time has elapsed



An audible signal sounds. The oven stops heating. 0:00 is shown in the display.

Setting the clock

Once the appliance is connected, "00:00" will blink, buzzer will ring once. Set the clock.

1. Turn the  knob between 00:00 and 23:59.
2. Touch the  key.
The time is set.

Changing the clock


1. Touch and hold the  key for 3 seconds in waiting state.
The actual time disappear and then the time will blink in the display.
2. Turn the right knob to set the new time and touch the  key to confirm the setting.

3.12. Child Lock Operation




Switching on the childproof lock

Requirement: No cooking time should be set and the function selector is in the off position.

Touch and hold the  and  keys for approx. 3 seconds.

The  symbol appears in the display. The childproof lock is activated.

Switching off the childproof lock

Touch and hold the  and  keys for approx. 3 seconds. The  symbol on the display goes out. The childproof lock is deactivated.

Childproof lock with other cooking operations

When other cooking programmes have been set, the childproof lock is not operational.

Section 4. Maintenance

Before any maintenance or cleaning work is carried out, **DISCONNECT** the appliance from the **ELECTRICITY** supply and ensure that the appliance is completely cool.

4.1. Internal Cleaning

Clean the interior and accessories with warm soapy water. Rinse and dry thoroughly. Do not use detergents, abrasive powders, highly perfumed cleaning products, wax polishes or cleaning products containing bleach or alcohol.

4.2. External Cleaning

Wash the fascia and door with warm soapy water. Do NOT use abrasive products.

4.3. What to do if something goes wrong

There is no power to the appliance:

- Check there is not a power cut
- Check there is power to the electric socket/appliance

The oven will not operate:

- Is the Timer control set to the required time?
- Has the door been closed correctly?
