To activate your guarantee, you will need your product serial number. This can be found on the rear of the machine.

Only house the extractor in rooms with adequate ventilation. Remember that the extractor is powerful and whatever air is extracted needs to be replaced.

Do not tile the extractor in. It should be removable for service or maintenance.

Do not use silicone sealant to secure the hood to the wall.

You must be able to isolate the extractor from the mains electrical supply after installation.

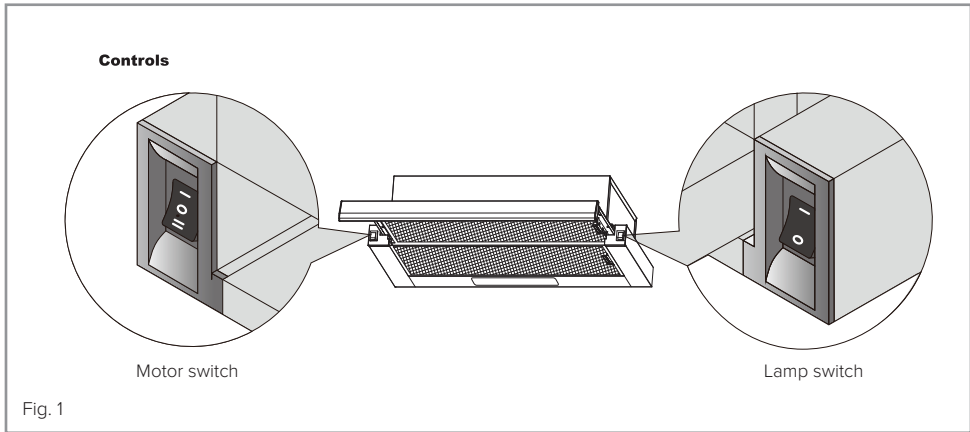
Steam cleaners must not be used when cleaning this appliance.

The performance of your extractor will vary depending on a number of factors. These include: type of extraction, length of ducting, room volume, ventilation available and cleanliness of the filters

Using your Extractor

For best performance, you should switch on the extractor 15 minutes before starting to cook and leave it to run for approximately 15 minutes after the end of cooking.

Control Panel



The telescopic canopy controls the electric power.
Pull out the telescopic panel to switch on the power; to switch power off, push the panel back in.
At either side of the panel are switches controlling the fan speed and the light.

- Light: switch button to "I" to illuminate the light.
switch button to "0" to turn it off.
- Speed: switch to "I" for low speed and "II" for high speed
"0" is the Off position.

Care and Maintenance

IMPORTANT : DO NOT PERFORM MAINTENANCE OR CLEANING OF THE EXTRACTOR WITHOUT FIRST SWITCHING OFF THE ELECTRICITY SUPPLY.

Cleaning

Use a non-abrasive cleaner. Any abrasive cleaner (including Cif) will scratch the surface and could erase the control panel markings.

You can clean your extractor effectively by simply using a dilute solution of water and mild detergent and drying to a shine with a clean cloth.

Cleaning the grease filter

The grease filter should be kept clean to minimise the risk of fire.

You should remove and clean the grease filter with hot soapy water at least once a month. You can also wash the grease filter in a dishwasher, ensuring that you place it in an upright position to prevent damage from other items in the dishwasher. After rinsing and drying, replace the filter.

To remove the grease filter, push in the button on the handle and then pull down on the filter at the front. When you have released it at the front, pull out the filter. To replace the grease filter, repeat the above steps in reverse.

Please note:

Cleaning the grease filter in the dishwasher may lead to discolouration. This is normal and does not constitute a fault with the appliance.

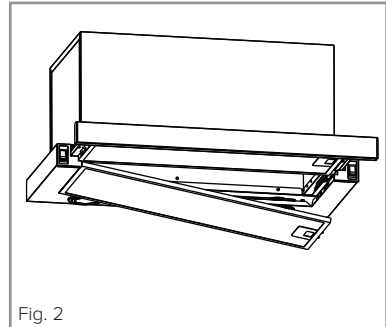

Changing the Light

NOTE: Replacement of the LED lamp must be carried out by a qualified electrician.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT PERFORM MAINTENANCE OR CLEANING OF THE EXTRACTOR WITHOUT FIRST SWITCHING OFF THE ELECTRICITY SUPPLY.

1. According fig.4-I take down grease filters.
2. According fig.4-II take down LED lamp.
3. According fig.4-III,install new LED lamp.
4. Installation grease filters.

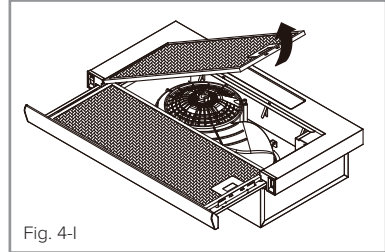

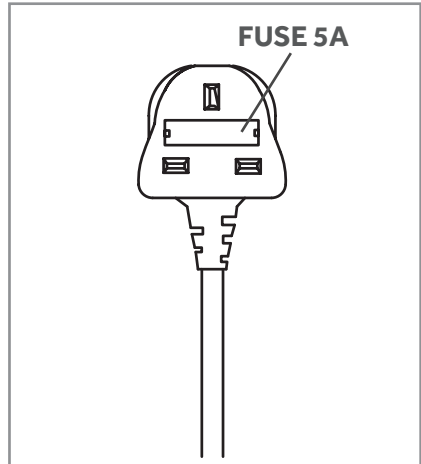
5A Fuse is installed inside the plug to protection line.

Troubleshooting

If your extractor is not working:

1. Check that the mains supply has not been switched off.
2. Check that the fuse in the spur has not blown.

Mounting your Extractor

Information

Ensure the power has been turned off before beginning this installation.

Before installing the cooker hood, please first fix the damper flap on the air outlet of the hoods.

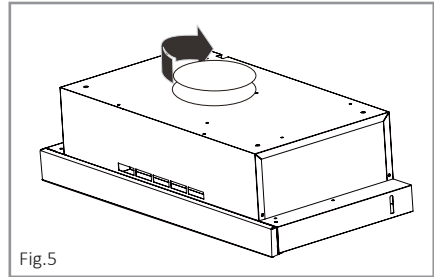

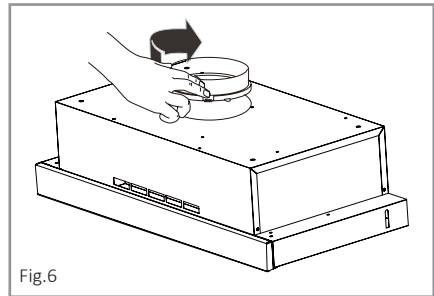

Decorative strip installation

As shown in Figure 7, fix the wide retainer plate (16mm) to the machine with 2 screws.

At this time, the extension length of the fixing plate should be 10mm, and the two screws pass through the sliding plate long hole and fixed on the fixing plate, adjust the sliding plate to the proper position, and tighten the screw nail. This state decorative panel extends from 10mm to 24mm.

As shown in Figure 8, fix the etainer plate narrow side (10mm) to the machine with 2 screws.

At this time, the extension length of the fixing plate should be 16mm, and the two screws pass through the sliding plate long hole and fixed on the fixing plate, adjust the sliding plate to the proper position, and tighten the screw nail. This state decorative panel extends from 16mm to 30mm.

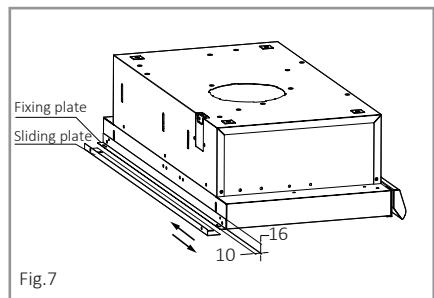

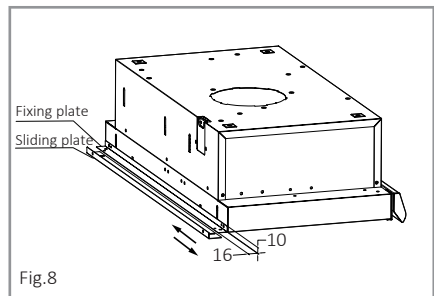

Mounting your Extractor

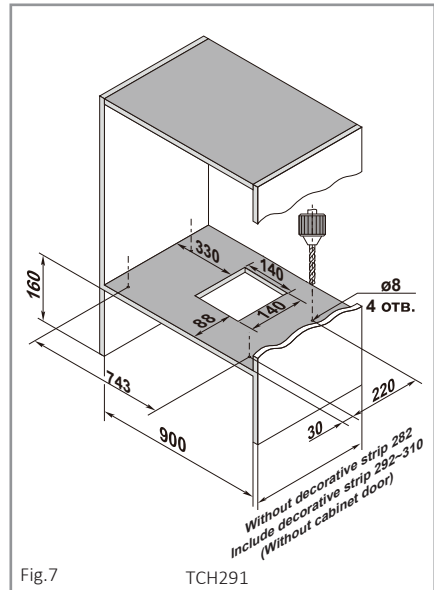
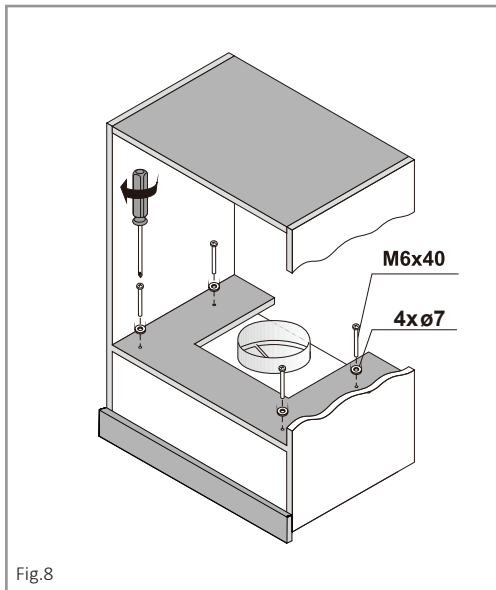
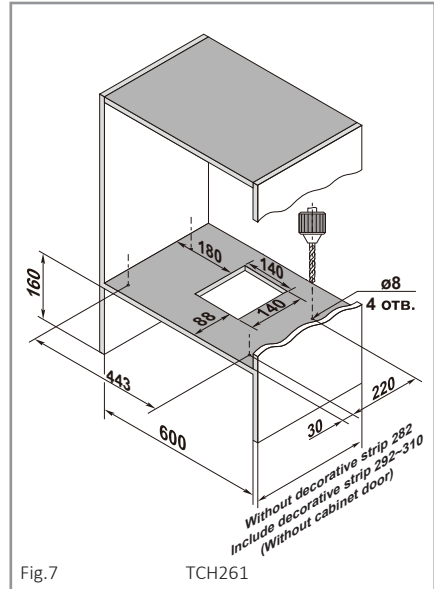
Information

When cutting or drilling into wall or ceiling, do not damage electrical wiring or other hidden utilities.

Fix the position of the hood according to Fig.7 above. Then use the stencil to drill out 4 holes in the cabinet. Insert rawl plugs and screws to correspond with the 4 holes.

The distance between the bottom of the hood and the cabinet on either side should be less than 2mm. Ensure that there is no gap between the top of the hood and the cabinet.

The gap at the back should be no more than 10mm and the plug must be accessible.



Mounting your Extractor

The cooker hood can be vented in different ways according to requirements:

Connect the hose (not supplied) with the air duct (Fig.8).

Vertical is the most common. If your kitchen has an attic space above, the ducting may be run up through the cupboard and attic to the roof (Fig.9).

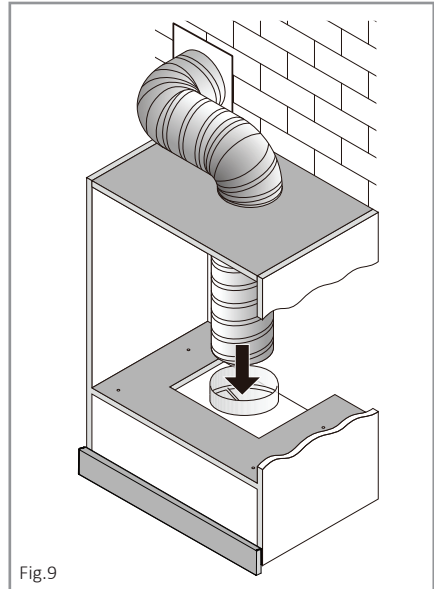

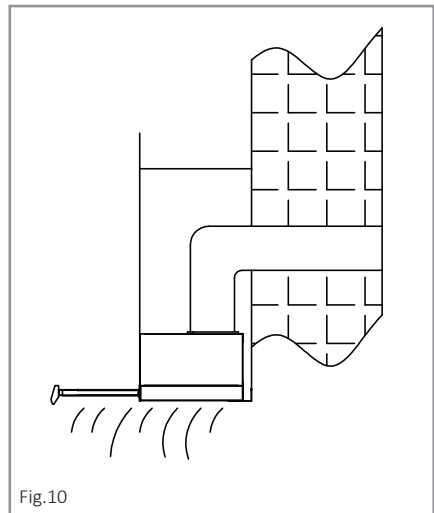
